CPD HOURS

Aim

The aim of these half-day courses is to refresh HNE Health medical officers and nursing staff in the theory and practical skills, both technical and teamwork skills, to manage a cardiac arrest.

Outline

The course includes readings sent prior to the course, lectures, and simulation scenarios, including use of a manual and or SAED (Shock Advisory External Defibrillator), transcutaneous pacing, the role of drugs in cardiac arrest, effective bag-mask ventilation and insertion of a Laryngeal Mask Airway.

Content

Content is based on recommendations from the Australian Resuscitation Council and on crisis resource management (CRM) principles including effective leadership, communication, distribution of workload, and assertiveness.

Prerequisites

Proficiency with Basic Life Support and familiarity with Advanced Life Support

Please note the HNEESC also offers a full day ALS course, SEALS, which is suitable for nursing staff and all medical officer levels.

CPD / Assessment

Nursing staff – if you wish to be signed off in My Health Learning for ALS competency you must provide evidence of having completed Edmore online ALS theory and assessment no longer than 3 months prior to the course date. Please bring this to our attention at the time of booking as additional time will need to be allowed for the practical assessment.

Medical staff – if you need to be assessed to meet College requirements, please bring this to our attention at the time of registration as additional time will need to be allowed during the course.
