- Reinforce the use of a systematic approach to the assessment and management of any ED patient
- Perform a rapid assessment/primary & secondary survey and initiate early management of patients presenting to the emergency department
- Provide an opportunity for you to practice teamwork skills including coordination of resources, leadership and followership, and speaking up for safety
