Gloves off

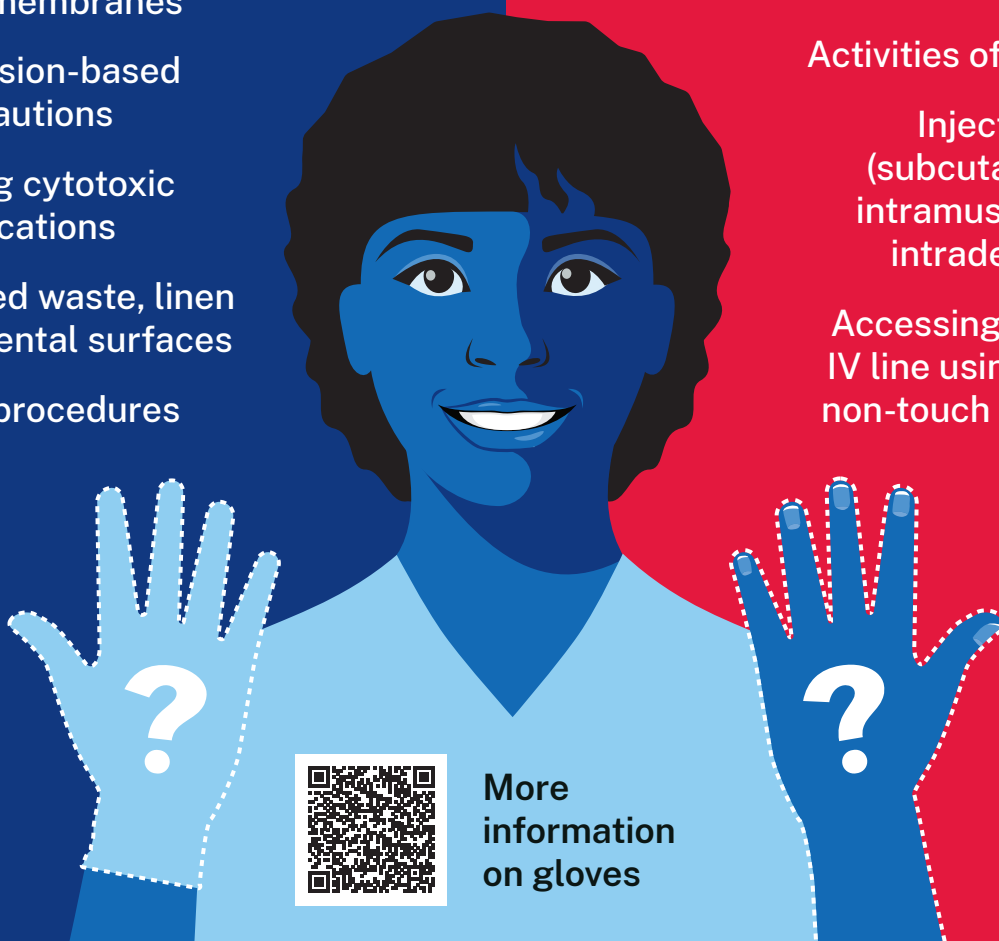
Intact skin to intact skin
