## **Lactation Support Service**

Our lactation support service offers parents and caregivers access to a personalised consultation with an International Board Certified Lactation Consultant (IBCLC).

Lactation appointments can be either face to face in the clinic or by video consultation using *my Virtual Care*.

#### We can help with:

- · Planning for breastfeeding success
- Support after experiencing difficulties last time
- · Breastfeeding after breast surgery
- Positioning and latching support
- Establishing feeding in the early days
- · Nipple concerns or damage
- · Problems with milk flow or letdown
- Oversupply or undersupply
- · Engorgement or mastitis
- Support and guidance if using alternate methods of feeding and lactation aids
- · Check baby's weight
- · Follow-up of infant feeding plan

If you have had your baby, you are welcome to contact us anytime within the first six weeks after birth or following discharge.

We can provide care during your pregnancy to help you prepare for breastfeeding.



# Lactation Support Service antenatal appointments at 34-36 weeks focus on:

- The importance of breastfeeding
- Benefits of skin to skin
- · Becoming familiar with your breasts
- · How breastfeeding works
- · Antenatal expressing
- · Full antenatal breast assessment
- What to expect in the first week
- Discussing alternate methods of oral feeding and lactation aids

There is no cost to you from HNELHD if you are Medicare eligible.

### How to book an appointment:

If unable to attend, please notify clinic on **6592 9808** so that your appointment can be offered to another family in need.

#### On the day of your appointment:

- Please bring your baby's blue book
- If possible, please hold off feeding your baby for 2 hours prior to the appointment (within reason)
- Partners and support persons are welcome to attend appointments
