

Request for school vaccination records be added to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR)

Thank you for your request for vaccines given in the School Immunisation Program to be added to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR). We will email you once vaccines have been added, this may take up to 14 days.

The AIR is a national register that has now expanded to be an all of life immunisation register.

An updated Immunisation History Statement can then be obtained by calling AIR on 1800 653 809 or through you/your child's MyGov account. <u>This link may be helpful in accessing AIR records online.</u> Children from 14 years must have their own MyGov account or will need to be present when calling Medicare.

Return request form by post or email to contact details above. Ensure <u>ALL</u> fields are completed to enable us to find these records. Please note if you or your child attended a school outside the map area, you will need to contact the Public Health Unit in that area.

All students were given a 'Record of Vaccination' card when vaccinated at school. Check if you have this record card before sending your request as this is adequate proof of vaccination.
