Transition to Professional Practice (TPP)

Our program at Maitland Hospital is designed around the Clinical practice setting. Emphasis is placed on clinical skill development and consolidation of learned knowledge. You will have rotations across acute clinical areas as well a rotation in a Critical Care area. You may also have the opportunity to experience the diverse nature of the rural Registered Nurse at one of our rural facilities, Dungog District Hospital.

Orientation and Professional Development

Our orientation program is designed to facilitate your induction to both Hospital and clinical environments, with supernumerary days at the beginning of each rotation. We pride ourselves in providing ongoing support for the duration of the TPP, including 5 education days as part of your professional development.

Clinical Rotation Support

Graduates will work with preceptors and Clinical Nurse Educators to gain familiarity within new clinical areas to develop clinical skills that build on knowledge and competency.

Permanent Contract

The TTP Program is a full time 12 month program, although we're open to negotiation for part time. At the end of the 12 month program you will have a permanent position at Maitland Hospital.

We are continuously developing 2nd year transition to specialty practice opportunities to support ongoing professional career development, so come join us and be part of our dynamic and innovative team.
