Boggabri MPS is a 22-bed facility, consisting of 16 residential aged care beds, 4 acute care (including 1 palliative care bed) and 2 emergency beds. Clinical services include emergency, general inpatient and community health. Allied services are available through Narrabri Hospital on a referral basis. The hospital is serviced by 1 full time GP VMO who is responsible for all residential clients, acute inpatients and all emergency presentations. Boggabri MPS also offers a five day a week community health service of wound care, catheter care, PICC line management and medication administration and in home palliative care.

The Transition to Professional Practice (TPP) Program

Boggabri MPS offers an integrated twelve month program to the new graduate nurse. Clinical placements in integrated rural health services such as Boggabri MPS provide newly registered nurses with a wide variety of clinical experiences and skill development opportunities. The Transition to Professional Practice (TPP) Program offered at this facility includes:

- A 12-month program
- Clinical guidance and support at ward level by Senior Registered Nurses, Health Service Manager and Clinical Nurse Educator.
- Study leave release to attend the planned TPP Study Days in Tamworth.
- In-service programs held regularly on site, and at request of the nurse.
- Education and accreditation in Advanced Life Support, Venepuncture and cannulation throughout the course of program.



Orientation

- A 1-week orientation consisting of days of collaboration with other Mehi sisters such as Wee Waa Community Hospital, Narrabri District Hospital, Moree District Hospital, Warialda MPS & Bingara MPS.

Clinical workbook

- Mehi Cluster New Graduate Handbook will be provided.

Support

- Support on site with access to CNE and senior nursing staff.

Leave entitlement

- Two weeks annual leave is rostered during the year at a time mutually agreed between the registered nurse and the Health Service Manager.
- The remainder of annual leave is at the completion of the program.
