Transition to Professional Practice (TTP)

The program at Cessnock and Kurri Kurri District Hospitals will focus on the skills of a rural facility Registered Nurse, with emphasis placed on developing your clinical and professional skills. You will have rotations across both sub acute inpatient units, critical care and specialty inpatient units (adult rehabilitation) to assist you in consolidating your knowledge and develop your clinical expertise.

Orientation and Professional Development

Our Orientation program is designed to facilitate your induction to all of the varying clinical environments supported with supernumerary days at the beginning of each rotation. Specific orientation to the rural setting will set you up to enjoy experiencing the diverse nature of the rural Registered Nurse.

Your professional development will be supported by an additional 5 education days during the program and further opportunities for specialist education. You will also be supported with supernumerary shifts

Clinical Rotation Support

Graduates will work with preceptors and Clinical Nurse Educators to gain familiarity within new clinical areas and develop clinical skills that build on knowledge and competency.
