SRMOs work under a level of supervision according to their competence in the following activities; Communicating assessment and management decisions to other staff involved in the patient's care. Communicating with the patient / family regarding the patient's condition and management plans. Coordinating diagnostic tests and consultations with other medical specialists.

Arranging the patient discharge process and liaising with local medical officers and community based care modalities for optimal post discharge care.
