Pre Requisites

This course is for HNE Health employees only and is suitable for re-credentialing Proficiency with Basic Life Support and familiarity with Advanced Life Support Refer to our Simulation Enhanced ALS (SEALS) course for initial credentialing

Location

HNE Simulation Centre, John Hunter Hospital Campus

The aim of these half-day courses is to provide a refresher in the management of adult cardiac arrest for HNE medical officers and nursing staff.

Content

This course will cover the knowledge and skills (technical and teamwork) required to manage a cardiac arrest. The course includes reading materials, mini-lectures, and simulation scenarios, including use of a manual and or SAED (Shock Advisory External Defibrillator), transcutaneous pacing, the role of drugs in cardiac arrest, effective bagmask ventilation and insertion of a Laryngeal Mask Airway. Course content is based on recommendations from the Australian Resuscitation Council and covers team working principles such as distributing workload, establishing role clarity, and using closed loop communication.

HNE ALS Requirements

If you wish to be assessed/signed off in My Health Learning (MHL) for ALS, you must provide evidence of completion for ALS theory and assessment no more than 6 weeks prior to your course date.
