

SERVICES AVAILABLE AT THE MAITLAND HOSPITAL AND INFORMATION

Inpatient services	<p>Patients who are staying at the hospital (admitted) receive these services.</p> <p>Inpatient units at The Maitland Hospital include: Surgical, Medical, Mental Health, Maternity, Special Care Nursery, Intensive care, Day surgery and Paediatric.</p>
Outpatient services	<p>Patients who attend the hospital for an appointment. A referral is required for all outpatient services.</p> <p>Outpatient services at The Maitland Hospital include: Dental, Renal Dialysis, Antenatal (Maternity), Paediatric, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Medical Imaging, Paediatric Dietician, Blood collection, Fracture/Orthopaedic clinic, Rural Rehabilitation.</p>
Medical unit	Unit where people who are sick with a range of issues will be treated.
Surgical unit	Unit where people recover after having surgery.
Mental health unit	Treatment of conditions relating to the mind/brain/wellbeing
Dental service	Public dentist to assess and treat your teeth.
Renal Dialysis service	Unit to treat patients with kidney disease.
Maternity and child services	Services to manage mothers before, during and after giving birth.
Special Care Nursery	Babies requiring close monitoring and treatment.
Intensive care Unit	Unit for patients requiring close monitoring and high treatment needs.
Emergency department	Assessment of urgent patients that cannot wait to see their GP.
Paediatric clinic	Clinics children attend as outpatients.
Paediatric unit	Unit in the hospital for children.
Paediatric Hospital in the Home	Service for children requiring ongoing management by clinicians in their home.

Allied Health	Group of professions that includes: Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Pharmacy and Medical Imaging. See below for individual definitions.
Physiotherapy	Outpatient service for people with pain or recovering from an illness or injury.
Occupational Therapy	Outpatient service that assists people in living within their current functional ability and working towards regaining normal and desired function.
Pharmacy	Hospital pharmacy for inpatients.
Medical Imaging (X-Ray)	Taking pictures of your body with a variety of methods: Includes X-Ray, MRI, CT scans, Ultrasound.
Addison clinic	Located on the 3 rd floor of the Addison Building. Outpatient clinic appointments : Antenatal Gynaecology General Medical General Surgical Geriatric Respiratory
Blood collection (Pathology North)	Nurse performs blood tests.
Fracture clinic/ Orthopaedic clinic	Doctors assess or follow up pain, injuries or surgery involving joints, muscles, bones and soft tissues.
Clinical Information	Medical records department.
Rural Rehabilitation Service	Outpatient service that assists patients with education, exercise and support with cardiac or respiratory illness.
